### The feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary on October 7th




#### Our Lady of the Holy Rosary

October is the Month of the Holy Rosary, when we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary on 7<sup>th</sup> October. Known for several centuries by the alternative title of 'Our Lady of Victory', the feast day is in honour of a 16<sup>th</sup> century naval victory when Europe won against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, when the Pope asked the whole of Europe to pray the Rosary on the day of the battle.
