- providing access to these signed Masses via Zoom which enables you access to regular signed Mass on Sundays and some Holy Days
- all Fr Paul's signed Masses are edited immediately after the live Zoom Mass each Sunday morning, then uploaded to CDA Facebook and CDA YouTube; the link is also added to our website: www.catholicdeaf.org.uk
- subscription to Zoom also means we are able have regular meetings such as Council members, committee meetings, AGMs etc, cutting down on the cost of travelling as well as time taken up while travelling
- maintaining our website through a web hosting subscription funded by your membership. This enables us to sahre news and information for the Deaf community throughout England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland (both North and South)
- Fr Paul Fletcher SJ also offers annual 1–to–1 Ignatian retreats every August at the Briery, Ilkley. Deaf people are welcome to book directly with the
