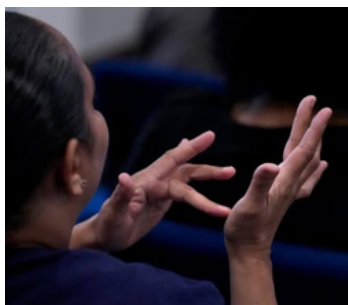
Heavenly Father, we lift up all the children who are preparing to go back to school and resume their education. We ask that You cover them with

Saturday 5th September 2026

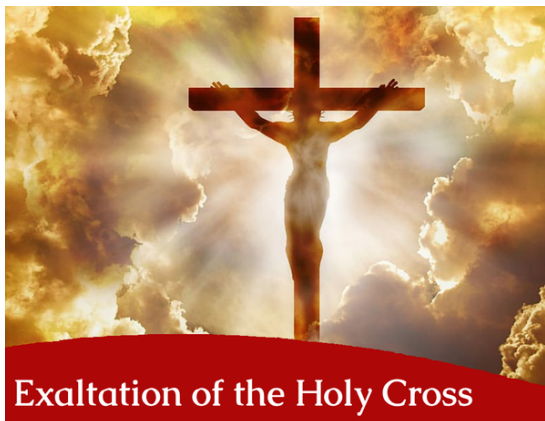
People from across the Archdiocese of Liverpool are invited to take part in a special pilgrimage walk as part of the Season of Creation celebrations.

The walk will begin at St Clare and St Hugh Church in Sefton and finish at St Anthony of Padua Church in Mossley Hill, where pilgrims will gather for Holy Mass.

The pilgrimage will offer an opportunity for prayer, fellowship and reflection on our responsibility to care for God's creation.



The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross Sunday September 14



If we look at this in a deeper sense, the feast also celebrates the Holy Cross as the instrument of our salvation. We make the Sign of the Cross before prayer which helps to fix our minds and hearts to God. After prayer we make the Sign of the Cross to keep close to God. During trials and temptations our strength and protection is the Sign of the Cross.

At Baptism we are sealed with the Sign of the Cross, signifying the fullness of redemption and that we belong to Christ. Let us look to the cross frequently, and realize that when we make the Sign of the Cross we give our entire self to God — mind, soul, heart, body, will, thoughts.
